

What should I already know?

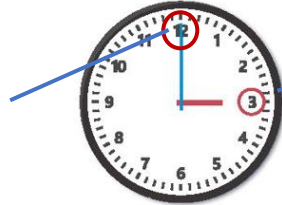
- Before describes the period of time preceding a particular event or time and after is the time following an event or period of time.
- The sequence of the days of the week and months of the year.

Key Knowledge

Tell (and draw) the time to the hour:

At the hour, the **minute hand** points to the 12
3 o'clock

The long hand is the **minute hand**



The short hand is the **hour hand**

The **hour hand** points to the hour.

Tell (and draw) the time to the half hour:

At half past, the **minute hand** is half way round the clock, pointing to the 6.

Half past 2



The hour hand will be **halfway** between one hour and the next.

Key Vocabulary and definitions

Time	To measure how long it takes for things to happen, how long ago things happened in the past and when things may happen in the future.
Clock	A device for measuring time, indicates hours, minutes, and sometimes seconds by hands on a round dial (or digital).
Hour	A period of time equal to 60 minutes.
Minute	A period of time equal to 60 seconds.
Clock hands	The hands (pointers) indicating the time on an analogue clock.
O'clock	Used to specify the hour when telling the time e.g. 5 o'clock.
Half past	Thirty minutes after (a specified hour).
Day	A 24-hour period from one midnight to the next.
Month	One of 12 periods which a year is divided into.
Week	A period of 7 days.
Weekend	Saturday and Sunday.
Year	A period of 365 days.
